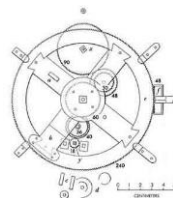
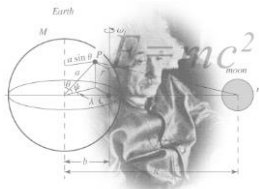


Physics Extra Credit Music Video

Assignment: Create a music video of a song that teaches a physics topic.

Extra Credit Points: Earn up to 20 extra credit points in the exam category

Guidelines:

- 1) You may work by yourself or in groups of two or three. Each person may receive up to 20 points of extra credit. All members of the group must contribute! (Contributing does not necessarily mean singing).
- 2) Yes, you may work with students from other class periods.
- 3) You must create a song that teaches a physics topic. Your goal is for a non-physics student to begin to understand your topic.
- 4) All aspects of the video must be **school appropriate**.
- 5) If you wish to include any person or reference to a person in your video, you must first receive their explicit permission.
- 6) The song must be either uploaded online with a link sent or delivered on a thumb drive. By submitting the video, you are giving Mr. Greenberg permission to show your work to other physics classes.
- 7) The song should be 3-6 minutes long.
- 8) Showing your lyrics is optional, but strongly recommended.
- 9) Full credit is not guaranteed. The quality, effort and accuracy of the physics will be taken into consideration.
- 10) Be creative and have fun with this!
